

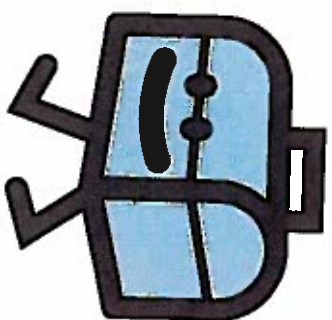


Summer can be a very challenging time for families as they try to make ends meet without the assistance of meals provided by the Free and Reduced Lunch Program offered at our area schools. Seeing the growing need in the North Harford area, and with the generous support of our donors, Mason-Dixon Community Services is initiating a program, the 2014 Summer Lunch Box Program, to feed the children in our service area.

Mason-Dixon Community Services (MDCS) has been serving Northern Harford County for nearly 30 years. We are located in the Highland Commons Building (also housing the Street Post Office and Rec fields) at 708 Highland Rd Street, MD 21154. Client service hours are Monday thru Thursday from 9 am. till noon, where income-eligible families (generally households receiving SNAP benefits, TCA, Medical Assistance &/or HCPS Free or Reduced Meal Program) receive a monthly food distribution. MDCS provides a variety of other community services and resources including case management, energy assistance, comprehensive referral services, school supply assistance, Christmas assistance, and employment assistance.

# 2014 Summer Lunch Box Program



Participating families will receive, in addition to the routine monthly food distribution, a monthly "lunch box" containing child-friendly breakfast and lunch options. We have already gathered cereal, pancake mix, syrup, toaster pastries, juice boxes, macaroni & cheese, peanut butter, jelly, canned chili, canned pasta, a variety of soups, tuna, Vienna Sausages, hot dogs, cookies, chips and snacks. Families may choose to opt to receive a monthly "lunch box" only. "Lunch boxes" will be available during our regular client service hours \***Mon - Thurs 9 am - noon\***

## Eligibility

Eligible families must have at least one child enrolled in one of the following schools North Harford MS, North Harford ES, Norrisville ES, Jarrettsville ES, North Bend ES, Dublin ES, or Darlington ES. Size of "Lunch Box" will be dependent upon number of children enrolled in the above schools. Proof of household residency in the MDCS North Harford service area and proof of financial necessity (can be the FRLP award letter for 2013-2014, SNAP benefit award letter, or TCA award letter) must be provided.



## Complete Application

Please use black pen to complete the following application. You may mail the completed application, bring it to 708 Highland Road during our service hours prior to the last day of school, or you may bring your application with you for your first pick-up between June 16<sup>th</sup> and June 30<sup>th</sup>. Application deadline is June 30<sup>th</sup>. Acceptance of application entitles you to 3 "Lunch Boxes", one between June 16<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup>, one anytime in July, and one anytime in August.
